1 AMEND Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 81, Page 2, Section 162.1195, Line 24,
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 “[163.037. In any school year after the 2009-10 school year, if there is a twenty-five
5 percent decrease in the statewide percentage of average daily attendance attributable to summer
6 school compared to the percentage of average daily attendance attributable to summer school in
7 the 2005-06 school year, then for the subsequent school year, weighted average daily attendance,
8 as such term is defined in section 163.011, shall include the addition of the product of twenty-five
9 hundredth times the average daily attendance for summer school.]

10 Section B. Because of the need to provide adequate funding to school districts, the repeal
11 of section 163.037 of section A of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of
12 the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within
13 the meaning of the constitution, and the repeal of section 163.037 of section A of this act shall be
14 in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.” ; and

16 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
17 accordingly.
