1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 71, Page 1, In the Title, Line 2, by  
 2 deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu thereof the  
 3 following:

4 "To repeal sections 215.020 and 339.1115, RSMo, and to enact  
 5 in lieu thereof two new sections"; and

6 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Lines 1 and 2,  
 7 by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the  
 8 following:

9 "Section A. Sections 215.020 and 339.1115, RSMo, are  
 10 repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be  
 11 known as sections 215.020 and 339.1115, to read as follows:

12 215.020. 1. There is hereby created and established as a  
 13 governmental instrumentality of the state of Missouri the  
 14 "Missouri Housing Development Commission" which shall constitute  
 15 a body corporate and politic.

16 2. The commission shall consist of the governor, lieutenant  
 17 governor, the state treasurer, the state attorney general, and  
 18 six members to be selected by the governor, with the advice and  
 19 consent of the senate. The persons to be selected by the  
 20 governor shall be individuals knowledgeable in the areas of  
 21 housing, finance or construction. Not more than four of the  
 22 members appointed by the governor shall be from the same  
 23 political party. The members of the commission appointed by the  
 24 governor shall serve the following terms: Two shall serve two  
 25 years, two shall serve three years, and two shall serve four  
 26 years, respectively. Thereafter, each appointment shall be for a  
 27 term of four years. If for any reason a vacancy occurs, the  
 28 governor, with the advice and consent of the senate, shall  
 29 appoint a new member to fill the unexpired term. Members are

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1 eligible for reappointment.

2 3. Six members of the commission shall constitute a quorum.  
3 No vacancy in the membership of the commission shall impair the  
4 right of a quorum to exercise all the rights and perform all the  
5 duties of the commission. No action shall be taken by the  
6 commission except upon the affirmative vote of at least six of  
7 the members of the commission.

8 4. Each member of the commission appointed by the governor  
9 is entitled to compensation of fifty dollars per diem plus his  
10 reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in  
11 discharging his duties under sections 215.010 to 215.250.

12 5. The department staff shall report to an executive  
13 director who shall be appointed by the governor and such  
14 executive director shall implement only those policies which are  
15 presented by the executive director and approved by the  
16 commission.

17 6. The employment of the executive director, including the  
18 executive director serving in such capacity on the effective date  
19 of this section, shall be subject to the advice and consent of  
20 the senate in the same manner as an appointment subject to the  
21 provisions of article IV, section 51 of the Missouri Constitution  
22 and shall be for a term of three years subject to reappointment  
23 for additional terms. Each additional term shall be subject to  
24 the advice and consent of the senate."; and

25 Further amend said title, enacting clause and intersectional  
26 references accordingly.
