1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 0071, Section A, Page 1, Line 2, by inserting the following after all of  
2 said Line:

3 "215.020. 1. There is hereby created and established as a governmental instrumentality of the state  
4 of Missouri the "Missouri Housing Development Commission" which shall constitute a body corporate  
5 and politic.

6 2. The commission shall consist of the governor, lieutenant governor, the state treasurer, the state  
7 attorney general, and six members to be selected by the governor, with the advice and consent of the  
8 senate. The persons to be selected by the governor shall be individuals knowledgeable in the areas of  
9 housing, finance or construction. Not more than four of the members appointed by the governor shall be  
10 from the same political party. The members of the commission appointed by the governor shall serve the  
11 following terms: Two shall serve two years, two shall serve three years, and two shall serve four years,  
12 respectively. Thereafter, each appointment shall be for a term of four years. If for any reason a vacancy  
13 occurs, the governor, with the advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a new member to fill the  
14 unexpired term. Members are eligible for reappointment.

15 3. Six members of the commission shall constitute a quorum. No vacancy in the membership of  
16 the commission shall impair the right of a quorum to exercise all the rights and perform all the duties of  
17 the commission. No action shall be taken by the commission except upon the affirmative vote of at least  
18 six of the members of the commission.

19 4. Each member of the commission appointed by the governor is entitled to compensation of fifty  
20 dollars per diem plus his reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in discharging his duties  
21 under sections 215.010 to 215.250.

22 5. The employment of an executive director or chief executive officer by the commission shall be  
23 for a term of three years and subject to reappointment for additional terms; each term shall be subject to  
24 the advice and consent of the senate in the same manner as an appointment subject to the provisions of  
25 article IV, section 51, of the Missouri Constitution. The term of the executive director or chief executive  
26 officer serving in such capacity on the effective date of this act shall expire on December 31, 2011, and  
27 such person may be reappointed under the provisions of this section.”; and

29 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
30 accordingly.
