1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 161, Page 3,
 2 Section 67.1008, Line 13, by inserting after all of said line the
 3 following:

4 "67.1360. 1. The governing body of the following cities
 5 and counties may impose a tax as provided in this section:

6 (1) A city with a population of more than seven thousand
 7 and less than seven thousand five hundred;

8 (2) A county with a population of over nine thousand six
 9 hundred and less than twelve thousand which has a total assessed
 10 valuation of at least sixty-three million dollars, if the county
 11 submits the issue to the voters of such county prior to January
 12 1, 2003;

13 (3) A third class city which is the county seat of a county
 14 of the third classification without a township form of government
 15 with a population of at least twenty-five thousand but not more
 16 than thirty thousand inhabitants;

17 (4) Any fourth class city having, according to the last
 18 federal decennial census, a population of more than one thousand
 19 eight hundred fifty inhabitants but less than one thousand nine
 20 hundred fifty inhabitants in a county of the first classification
 21 with a charter form of government and having a population of
 22 greater than six hundred thousand but less than nine hundred
 23 thousand inhabitants;

24 (5) Any city having a population of more than three
 25 thousand but less than eight thousand inhabitants in a county of
 26 the fourth classification having a population of greater than
 27 forty-eight thousand inhabitants;

28 (6) Any city having a population of less than two hundred
 29 fifty inhabitants in a county of the fourth classification having

1 a population of greater than forty-eight thousand inhabitants;

2 (7) Any fourth class city having a population of more than
3 two thousand five hundred but less than three thousand
4 inhabitants in a county of the third classification having a
5 population of more than twenty-five thousand but less than
6 twenty-seven thousand inhabitants;

7 (8) Any third class city with a population of more than
8 three thousand two hundred but less than three thousand three
9 hundred located in a county of the third classification having a
10 population of more than thirty-five thousand but less than
11 thirty-six thousand;

12 (9) Any county of the second classification without a
13 township form of government and a population of less than thirty
14 thousand;

15 (10) Any city of the fourth class in a county of the second
16 classification without a township form of government and a
17 population of less than thirty thousand;

18 (11) Any county of the third classification with a township
19 form of government and a population of at least twenty-eight
20 thousand but not more than thirty thousand;

21 (12) Any city of the fourth class with a population of more
22 than one thousand eight hundred but less than two thousand in a
23 county of the third classification with a township form of
24 government and a population of at least twenty-eight thousand but
25 not more than thirty thousand;

26 (13) Any city of the third class with a population of more
27 than seven thousand two hundred but less than seven thousand five
28 hundred within a county of the third classification with a
29 population of more than twenty-one thousand but less than
30 twenty-three thousand;

31 (14) Any fourth class city having a population of more than
32 two thousand eight hundred but less than three thousand one
33 hundred inhabitants in a county of the third classification with
34 a township form of government having a population of more than
35 eight thousand four hundred but less than nine thousand
36 inhabitants;

37 (15) Any fourth class city with a population of more than

1 four hundred seventy but less than five hundred twenty
2 inhabitants located in a county of the third classification with
3 a population of more than fifteen thousand nine hundred but less
4 than sixteen thousand inhabitants;

5 (16) Any third class city with a population of more than
6 three thousand eight hundred but less than four thousand
7 inhabitants located in a county of the third classification with
8 a population of more than fifteen thousand nine hundred but less
9 than sixteen thousand inhabitants;

10 (17) Any fourth class city with a population of more than
11 four thousand three hundred but less than four thousand five
12 hundred inhabitants located in a county of the third
13 classification without a township form of government with a
14 population greater than sixteen thousand but less than sixteen
15 thousand two hundred inhabitants;

16 (18) Any fourth class city with a population of more than
17 two thousand four hundred but less than two thousand six hundred
18 inhabitants located in a county of the first classification
19 without a charter form of government with a population of more
20 than fifty-five thousand but less than sixty thousand
21 inhabitants;

22 (19) Any fourth class city with a population of more than
23 two thousand five hundred but less than two thousand six hundred
24 inhabitants located in a county of the third classification with
25 a population of more than nineteen thousand one hundred but less
26 than nineteen thousand two hundred inhabitants;

27 (20) Any county of the third classification without a
28 township form of government with a population greater than
29 sixteen thousand but less than sixteen thousand two hundred
30 inhabitants;

31 (21) Any county of the second classification with a
32 population of more than forty-four thousand but less than fifty
33 thousand inhabitants;

34 (22) Any third class city with a population of more than
35 nine thousand five hundred but less than nine thousand seven
36 hundred inhabitants located in a county of the first
37 classification without a charter form of government and with a

1 population of more than one hundred ninety-eight thousand but
2 less than one hundred ninety-eight thousand two hundred
3 inhabitants;

4 (23) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
5 five thousand two hundred but less than five thousand three
6 hundred inhabitants located in a county of the third
7 classification without a township form of government and with
8 more than twenty-four thousand five hundred but less than
9 twenty-four thousand six hundred inhabitants;

10 (24) Any third class city with a population of more than
11 nineteen thousand nine hundred but less than twenty thousand in a
12 county of the first classification without a charter form of
13 government and with a population of more than one hundred
14 ninety-eight thousand but less than one hundred ninety-eight
15 thousand two hundred inhabitants;

16 (25) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
17 two thousand six hundred but less than two thousand seven hundred
18 inhabitants located in any county of the third classification
19 without a township form of government and with more than fifteen
20 thousand three hundred but less than fifteen thousand four
21 hundred inhabitants;

22 (26) Any county of the third classification without a
23 township form of government and with more than fourteen thousand
24 nine hundred but less than fifteen thousand inhabitants;

25 (27) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
26 five thousand four hundred but fewer than five thousand five
27 hundred inhabitants and located in more than one county;

28 (28) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
29 six thousand three hundred but fewer than six thousand five
30 hundred inhabitants and located in more than one county through
31 the creation of a tourism district which may include, in addition
32 to the geographic area of such city, the area encompassed by the
33 portion of the school district, located within a county of the
34 first classification with more than ninety-three thousand eight
35 hundred but fewer than ninety-three thousand nine hundred
36 inhabitants, having an average daily attendance for school year
37 2005-06 between one thousand eight hundred and one thousand nine

1 hundred;

2 (29) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
3 seven thousand seven hundred but less than seven thousand eight
4 hundred inhabitants located in a county of the first
5 classification with more than ninety-three thousand eight hundred
6 but less than ninety-three thousand nine hundred inhabitants;

7 (30) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
8 two thousand nine hundred but less than three thousand
9 inhabitants located in a county of the first classification with
10 more than seventy-three thousand seven hundred but less than
11 seventy-three thousand eight hundred inhabitants;

12 (31) Any city of the third classification with more than
13 nine thousand three hundred but less than nine thousand four
14 hundred inhabitants;

15 (32) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
16 three thousand eight hundred but fewer than three thousand nine
17 hundred inhabitants and located in any county of the first
18 classification with more than thirty-nine thousand seven hundred
19 but fewer than thirty-nine thousand eight hundred inhabitants;

20 (33) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
21 one thousand eight hundred but fewer than one thousand nine
22 hundred inhabitants and located in any county of the first
23 classification with more than one hundred thirty-five thousand
24 four hundred but fewer than one hundred thirty-five thousand five
25 hundred inhabitants;

26 (34) Any county of the third classification without a
27 township form of government and with more than twelve thousand
28 one hundred but fewer than twelve thousand two hundred
29 inhabitants; [or]

30 (35) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
31 three thousand eight hundred but fewer than four thousand
32 inhabitants and located in more than one county; provided,
33 however, that motels owned by not-for-profit organizations are
34 exempt;

35 (36) Any city of the fourth classification with more than
36 seven thousand six hundred eighty but fewer than seven thousand
37 eight hundred inhabitants and located in any county with a

1 charter form of government and with more than one million
2 inhabitants.

3 2. The governing body of any city or county listed in
4 subsection 1 of this section may impose a tax on the charges for
5 all sleeping rooms paid by the transient guests of hotels,
6 motels, bed and breakfast inns and campgrounds and any docking
7 facility which rents slips to recreational boats which are used
8 by transients for sleeping, which shall be at least two percent,
9 but not more than five percent per occupied room per night,
10 except that such tax shall not become effective unless the
11 governing body of the city or county submits to the voters of the
12 city or county at a state general, primary or special election, a
13 proposal to authorize the governing body of the city or county to
14 impose a tax pursuant to the provisions of this section and
15 section 67.1362. The tax authorized by this section and section
16 67.1362 shall be in addition to any charge paid to the owner or
17 operator and shall be in addition to any and all taxes imposed by
18 law and the proceeds of such tax shall be used by the city or
19 county solely for funding the promotion of tourism. Such tax
20 shall be stated separately from all other charges and taxes.";
