1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 430, Pages 1 and 2, Section 301.3084, 2 Lines, 1 to 33, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 3 "301.3084. 1. Any person may receive special license plates as prescribed by this section, 4 for any motor vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned motor 5 vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross 6 weight[, after an annual contribution of an emblem-use authorization fee to the Friends of the 7 Missouri Women's Council. Any contribution to the Friends of the Missouri Women's Council 8 pursuant to this section, except reasonable administrative costs, shall be designated for the sole 9 purpose of providing breast cancer services, including but not limited to screening, treatment, 10 staging, and follow-up services. The Friends of the Missouri Women's Council hereby authorizes 11 the use of its official emblem to be affixed on multivear personalized license plates as provided in 12 this section. Any person may annually apply for the use of the emblem]. Upon making a twenty-13 five dollar annual contribution to the breast cancer awareness fund, established in this section, the 14 vehicle owner may apply for a "Breast Cancer Awareness" license plate. If the contribution is 15 made directly to the state treasurer, the state treasurer shall issue the individual making the contribution a receipt, verifying the contribution, that may be used to apply for the "Breast Cancer 16 17 Awareness" license plate. If the contribution is made directly to the director of revenue, the 18 director shall note the contribution and the owner may then apply for the "Breast Cancer 19 Awareness" plate. The applicant for such plate must pay a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the regular registration fees and present any other documentation required by law for each set of 20 21 "Breast Cancer Awareness" plates issued pursuant to this section. Notwithstanding the provisions 22 of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for the personalization of license plates 23 issued pursuant to this section. 24 2. [Upon annual application and payment of a twenty-five dollar emblem-use contribution 25 to the Friends of the Missouri Women's Council, the organization shall issue to the vehicle owner, 26 without further charge, an emblem-use authorization statement, which shall be presented by the 27 owner to the department of revenue at the time of registration of a motor vehicle. Upon 28 presentation of the annual statement, payment of a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the registration 29 fee and documents which may be required by law, the department of revenue shall issue to the

1	vehicle owner a personalized] The "Breast Cancer Awareness" license plate [which] shall bear a
2	graphic design depicting the breast cancer awareness pink ribbon symbol [with the words "Breast
3	Cancer Awareness" forming an oval around the symbol,] and shall bear the words ["MISSOURI
4	WOMEN'S COUNCIL"] BREAST CANCER AWARENESS" in place of the words "SHOW-ME
5	STATE". Such license plates shall be made with fully reflective material with a common color
6	scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as
7	prescribed by section 301.130. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no additional
8	fee shall be charged for the personalization of license plates pursuant to this section.
9	3. A vehicle owner, who was previously issued a plate with a breast cancer awareness
10	emblem authorized by this section but who does not provide an emblem-use authorization
11	statement at a subsequent time of registration, shall be issued a new plate which does not bear the
12	emblem, as otherwise provided by law. The director of revenue shall make necessary rules and
13	regulations for the administration of this section, and shall design all necessary forms required by
14	this section. No rule or portion of a rule promulgated pursuant to the authority of this section
15	shall become effective unless it has been promulgated pursuant to the provisions of chapter 536.
16	4. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Breast Cancer Awareness Fund" which
17	shall consist of all gifts, donations, transfers, and moneys appropriated by the general assembly,
18	and bequests to the fund. The fund shall be administered by the department of health and senior
19	services.
20	5. The state treasurer or the director of revenue shall deposit the twenty-five dollar annual
21	contribution in the breast cancer awareness fund. Funds deposited pursuant to subsection 1 of this
22	section shall be used to support breast cancer awareness activities conducted by the department of
23	health and senior services.
24	6. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund and may approve disbursements from
25	the fund in accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180. Notwithstanding the provisions of
26	section 33.080, to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall
27	not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the
28	fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such
29	investments shall be credited to the fund."; and
