1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 284, Page 1,
2 In the Title, Line 2, by inserting after the number "144.030,"
3 the number "215.020,"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 1, In the Title, Line 2, by
5 deleting the word "three" and inserting in lieu thereof the word
6 "four"; and

7 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Lines 1 and 2,
8 by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the
9 following:

10 "Section A. Sections 144.030, 215.020, 339.055, and
11 338.330, RSMO, are repealed and four new sections enacted in lieu
12 thereof, to be known as sections 144.030, 215.020, 338.055, and
13 338.330, to read"; and

14 Further amend said bill, Page 9, Section 144.030, Line 279,
15 by inserting after all of said line the following:

16 "215.020. 1. There is hereby created and established as a
17 governmental instrumentality of the state of Missouri the
18 "Missouri Housing Development Commission" which shall constitute
19 a body corporate and politic.

20 2. The commission shall consist of the governor, lieutenant
21 governor, the state treasurer, the state attorney general, and
22 six members to be selected by the governor, with the advice and
23 consent of the senate. The persons to be selected by the
24 governor shall be individuals knowledgeable in the areas of
25 housing, finance or construction. Not more than four of the
26 members appointed by the governor shall be from the same
27 political party. The members of the commission appointed by the
28 governor shall serve the following terms: Two shall serve two
29 years, two shall serve three years, and two shall serve four

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1 years, respectively. Thereafter, each appointment shall be for a
2 term of four years. If for any reason a vacancy occurs, the
3 governor, with the advice and consent of the senate, shall
4 appoint a new member to fill the unexpired term. Members are
5 eligible for reappointment.

6 3. Six members of the commission shall constitute a quorum.
7 No vacancy in the membership of the commission shall impair the
8 right of a quorum to exercise all the rights and perform all the
9 duties of the commission. No action shall be taken by the
10 commission except upon the affirmative vote of at least six of
11 the members of the commission.

12 4. Each member of the commission appointed by the governor
13 is entitled to compensation of fifty dollars per diem plus his
14 reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in
15 discharging his duties under sections 215.010 to 215.250.

16 5. The department staff shall report to an executive
17 director who shall be appointed by the governor and such
18 executive director shall implement only those policies which are
19 presented by the executive director and approved by the
20 commission.

21 6. The employment of the executive director, including the
22 executive director serving in such capacity on the effective date
23 of this section, shall be subject to the advice and consent of
24 the senate in the same manner as an appointment subject to the
25 provisions of article IV, section 51 of the Missouri Constitution
26 and shall be for a term of three years subject to reappointment
27 for additional terms. Each additional term shall be subject to
28 the advice and consent of the senate."; and

29 Further amend said title, enacting clause and intersectional
30 references accordingly.
