4. Each member of the commission appo	inted by the governor is entitled to compensation of fifty
dollars per diem plus his reasonable and necessar	ry expenses actually incurred in discharging his duties
under sections 215.010 to 215.250.	
5. The employment of an executive direction	ctor or chief executive officer by the commission shall be
for a term of three years and subject to reappoint	ment for additional terms; each term shall be subject to
the advice and consent of the senate in the same	manner as an appointment subject to the provisions of
article IV, section 51, of the Missouri Constitution	on. The term of the executive director or chief executive
officer serving in such capacity on the effective of	date of this act shall expire on December 31, 2011, and
such person may be reappointed under the provis	sions of this section."; and
