HB 265 -- Nursing Licenses

Sponsor: Smith (150)

This bill requires the State Board of Nursing in the Division of Professional Registration within the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, upon restricting or suspending a license, to notify any known current employer of a nurse whose license has been sanctioned. If an employer provides the board with a current list of nurse employees and requests in writing to be notified, the board must notify the employer regarding any change in the licensure status of any nurse employee.

The board is not required to determine the current employer of a sanctioned nurse.
