1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 594, Page 11, Section 407.1107, Line  
2 36, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

3 “407.1160. 1. No computerized telephone calls of a political nature shall be made to an  
4 individual's residence at any time other than between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. local time at the  
5 called individual's location.

6 2. Any person or entity responsible for authorizing the making of such telephone calls in violation  
7 of this section is guilty of an unlawful telemarketing act or practice and shall be subject to the penalties  
8 authorized in section 407.1082.

9 407.1162. 1. Any telephone calls of a political nature made in this state shall indicate the person  
10 or organization paying for such political telephone calls.

11 2. Any person or entity making such political telephone calls in violation of this section is guilty  
12 of an unlawful telemarketing act or practice and shall be subject to the penalties authorized in section  
13 407.1082.

14 570.195. 1. As used in this section the following terms shall mean:

15 (1) "Caller", a person who places a call by a telephone or over a telephone line, even if the person  
16 begins the call on a computer;

17 (2) "Caller identification system", a listing of a caller's name, telephone number, or name and  
18 telephone number that is shown to a recipient of a call when the recipient answers;

19 (3) "False information", data that misrepresents the identity of the caller to the recipient of a call;  
20 except that when a person making an authorized call on behalf of another person inserts the name,  
21 telephone number, or name and telephone number of the person on whose behalf the call is being made,  
22 such information shall not be deemed false information;

23 (4) "Insert", the insertion of data by voice communication, by written communication or by  
24 otherwise entering into a computer.

25 2. Any caller who knowingly inserts false information into a caller identification system with the  
26 intent to mislead, defraud, or deceive the recipient of a telephone call shall be guilty of caller  
27 identification spoofing.

28 3. Caller identification spoofing shall be a class D felony.

29 4. The provisions of this section shall not apply to:

30 (1) Any blocking of caller identification information;

1       (2) Any law enforcement agencies of the federal government, state government, a county or  
2 municipality; or  
3       (3) Any intelligence or security agencies of the federal government.”; and

5 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
6 accordingly.
