1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 0557, Page 1, In the title, Lines 3 and 4,
2 by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "relating to motor vehicles";
3 and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 7, Section 301.193, Line 68, by inserting after all of said line the
6 following:

7 "301.4040. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any person
8 after an annual payment of an emblem-use fee to the American Red Cross Trust Fund, may
9 receive specialty personalized license plates for any vehicle the member owns, either solely or
10 jointly, other than an apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess
11 of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight. The Missouri Chapter of the American Red Cross
12 hereby authorizes the use of its official emblem to be affixed on specialty license plates within the
13 plate area prescribed by the director of revenue and as provided in this section. Any contribution
14 to the American Red Cross derived from this section, except reasonable administrative costs, shall
15 be used solely for the purposes of the American Red Cross. Any person may annually apply for
16 the use of the emblem.

17 2. Upon annual application and payment of a twenty-five dollar emblem-use contribution
18 to the American Red Cross Trust Fund, the Missouri Chapter of the American Red Cross shall
19 issue to the vehicle owner, without further charge, an emblem-use authorization statement, which
20 shall be presented by the vehicle owner to the director of revenue at the time of registration. Upon
21 presentation of the annual emblem-use authorization statement and payment of a twenty-five
22 dollar fee in addition to the regular registration fees, and presentation of any documents which
23 may be required by law, the director of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner a specialty
24 personalized license plate which shall bear the emblem of the Missouri Chapter of the American
25 Red Cross, and the words "PROUD SUPPORTER" at the bottom of the plate, in a manner
26 prescribed by the director of revenue. Such license plates shall be made with fully reflective
27 material with a common color scheme and design of the standard license plate, shall be clearly
28 visible at night, shall have a reflective white background in the area of the plate configuration, and

1 shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130. Notwithstanding the provisions
2 of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for the personalization of license plates
3 issued under this section.

4 3. A vehicle owner who was previously issued a plate with the Missouri Chapter of the
5 American Red Cross' emblem authorized by this section, but who does not provide an
6 emblem-use authorization statement at a subsequent time of registration, shall be issued a new
7 plate which does not bear the Missouri Chapter of the American Red Cross' emblem, as otherwise
8 provided by law. The director of revenue shall make necessary rules and regulations for the
9 enforcement of this section, and shall design all necessary forms required by this section.

10 4. Prior to the issuance of a Missouri Chapter of the American Red Cross specialty
11 personalized plate authorized under this section, the department of revenue must be in receipt of
12 an application, as prescribed by the director, which shall be accompanied by a list of at least two
13 hundred potential applicants who plan to purchase the specialty personalized plate, the proposed
14 art design for the specialty license plate, and an application fee, not to exceed five thousand
15 dollars, to defray the department's cost for issuing, developing, and programming the
16 implementation of the specialty plate. Once the plate design is approved, the director of revenue
17 shall not authorize the manufacture of the material to produce such specialized license plates with
18 the individual seal, logo, or emblem until such time as the director has received two hundred
19 applications, the fifteen dollar specialty plate fee per application, and emblem-use statements, if
20 applicable, and other required documents or fees for such plates.

21 5. The specialty personalized plate shall not be redesigned unless the organization pays
22 the director in advance for all redesigned plate fees for the plate established in this section. If a
23 member chooses to replace the specialty personalized plate for the new design the member must
24 pay the replacement fees prescribed in section 301.300 for the replacement of the existing
25 specialty personalized plate. All other applicable license plate fees in accordance with this
26 chapter shall be required.

27 Section 1. 1. The department of transportation shall designate 1078 South Jefferson
28 Street in Lebanon recognizing the "Independent Stave Company" as a centennial business.

29 2. Costs associated with the erection and maintenance of such recognition shall be paid by
30 private donations.

31 Section 2. 1. The department of transportation shall designate 111 West Broadway in
32 Bolivar recognizing "Douglas, Haun, and Heidemann, P.C." as a centennial business.

33 2. Costs associated with the erection and maintenance of such recognition shall be paid by
34 private donations."; and

35 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
36 accordingly.
