contribution to the Pony Exp	press Museum derived from this section, except reasonable administrative	
costs, shall be used solely for	r the purposes of the Pony Express Museum. Any person may annually apply	
for the use of the emblem.		
2. Upon annual appl	lication and payment of a twenty-five dollar emblem-use contribution to the	
Pony Express Museum, the r	nuseum shall issue to the vehicle owner, without further charge, an	
emblem-use authorization sta	atement, which shall be presented by the vehicle owner to the director of	
revenue at the time of registr	ration. Upon presentation of the annual emblem-use authorization statement	
and payment of a twenty-five	e dollar fee in addition to the regular registration fees, and presentation of any	
documents which may be rec	quired by law, the director of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner a	
specialty personalized licens	e plate which shall bear the rider on horseback emblem, and the words "Pony	
Express" at the bottom of the	e plate, in a manner prescribed by the director of revenue. Such license plates	
shall be made with fully refle	ective material with a common color scheme and design of the standard	
license plate, shall be clearly	visible at night, shall have a reflective white background in the area of the	
plate configuration, and shall	1 be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130.	
Notwithstanding the provision	ons of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for the	
personalization of license pla	ates issued under this section.	
3. A vehicle owner	who was previously issued a plate with the Pony Express Museum's emblem	
authorized by this section, bu	ut who does not provide an emblem-use authorization statement at a	
subsequent time of registration	on, shall be issued a new plate which does not bear the Pony Express	
Museum's emblem, as otherv	wise provided by law. The director of revenue shall make necessary rules and	
regulations for the enforcement	ent of this section, and shall design all necessary forms required by this	
section.

1	4. Prior to the issuance of a Pony Express specialty personalized plate authorized under this	
2	section, the department of revenue must be in receipt of an application, as prescribed by the director,	
3	which shall be accompanied by a list of at least two hundred potential applicants who plan to purchase the	<u>1e</u>
4	specialty personalized plate, the proposed art design for the specialty license plate, and an application fe	e,
5	not to exceed five thousand dollars, to defray the department's cost for issuing, developing, and	
6	programming the implementation of the specialty plate. Once the plate design is approved, the director of	<u>of</u>
7	revenue shall not authorize the manufacture of the material to produce such specialized license plates wi	th
8	the individual seal, logo, or emblem until such time as the director has received two hundred application	<u>s,</u>
