1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 0648,
2 Senate Bill No. 648, Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by after all of said section and line inserting the
3 following:

5 "227.509. The portion of highway 64/40 between mile markers 10.2 and 12.8 in St. Charles
6 County shall be designated the "Darrell B. Roegner Memorial Highway." Costs for such designation shall
7 be paid by private donations.

9 301.3163. Any person may apply for [special] specialty personalized "Don't Tread on Me" motor
10 vehicle license plates for any vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned
11 motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight.
12 Such person shall make application for the [special] specialty personalized license plates on a form
13 provided by the director of revenue. The director shall then issue specialty personalized license plates
14 bearing letters or numbers or a combination thereof as determined by the [advisory committee established
15 in section 301.129] director, with the words "DON'T TREAD ON ME" [in place of the words
16 "SHOW-ME STATE"] centered on the bottom one-fourth of the plate, in bold, all capital letters, and with
17 lettering identical to the lettering used for the word "MISSOURI" on the regular state license plate. Such
18 words shall be no smaller than forty-eight point type. Such plates shall be tiger yellow beginning at the
19 top and bottom, with the color fading into white in the center. All numbers and letters shall be black. The
20 left side shall contain a reproduction of the "Gadsden Snake" in black and white, with the snake to be
21 three inches in height and two inches wide, and sitting on green grass that is two and one-quarter inches
22 wide. Upon payment of a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the regular registration fees, and presentation of
23 any documents which may be required by law, the director of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner a
24 specialty personalized plate. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be
25 charged for the personalization of license plates issued under this section. Such license plates shall be
26 made with fully reflective material with a common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at
27 night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130. "; and
