2. No vasectomy is a	authorized or shall be performed in violation of this section. In
determining whether a vasec	ctomy is necessary, no regard shall be made to the desire of a man to
father children, his economic	c situation, his age, the number of children he is currently responsible
for, or any danger to his wife	e or partner in the event a child is conceived. A vasectomy shall only
be performed to avert the de-	ath of the man or avert serious risk of substantial and irreversible
physical impairment of a ma	ajor bodily function of the man. No such condition shall be deemed to
exist if it is based on a diagn	nosis or claim of a mental or emotional condition of the man or that
the man will purposefully en	ngage in conduct which he intends to result in his death or in
substantial and irreversible p	physical impairment of a major bodily function.
3. No vasectomy is a	authorized or shall be performed unless the vasectomy is performed i
a licensed hospital, a license	ed ambulatory surgical center, or other health facility licensed by the
department of health and ser	nior services.
4. A vasectomy shal	l only be performed by a physician licensed under chapter 334.
5. Any person who p	performs a vasectomy or any person permitting a vasectomy to be
performed on him in violation	on of this section is guilty of a felony and upon a finding of guilt, sha
be sentenced to community s	service of not less than one thousand forty hours in the field of service
to needy families, caring for	or counseling abused and neglected children or wayward teens, or
performing service to inmate	es in a jail or correctional institution."; and
