2	4. The department shall establish an electronic mail mechanism through which persons
3	may ask questions about the program and receive assistance in completing the health information
4	card.
5	5. The department shall provide sufficient program materials to other state departments or
6	agencies seeking to distribute or make program materials available to interested persons.
7	6. The director shall notify the state highway patrol regarding the implementation of the
8	Missouri yellow dot program so that all emergency responders are informed about the program.
9	7. The department may charge an individual seeking to participate in the program a
10	nominal fee to cover the administrative cost of the program.
11	8. The department shall make Missouri yellow dot program materials available for pick
12	up by any interested person at any driver's license office and shall provide for an online means
13	through which individuals can request the materials required to participate in the program. Any
14	other state department or agency may make the program materials available for distribution to, or
15	pick up by, any interested person.
16	9. The department shall develop and undertake a public education campaign to inform the
17	public about the program established in this section.
18	10. The director may promulgate all necessary rules and regulations for the administration
19	of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is
20	created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with
21	and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This
22	section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general
23	assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul
24	a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule
25	proposed or adopted after August 28, 2012, shall be invalid and void.
26	11. Under section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:
27	(1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall automatically
28	sunset six years after the effective date of this section unless reauthorized by an act of the general
29	assembly; and
30	(2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this section shall
31	automatically sunset twelve years after the effective date of the reauthorization of this section; and
32	(3) This section shall terminate on September first of the calendar year immediately
33	following the calendar year in which the program authorized under this section is sunset."; and
