1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1458, Page 4, Section 320.202, Line 34, by  
2 inserting the following after all of said Line:

3 “321.015. 1. No person holding any lucrative office or employment under this state, or any  
4 political subdivision thereof as defined in section 70.120, shall hold the office of fire protection district  
5 director under this chapter. When any fire protection district director accepts any office or employment  
6 under this state or any political subdivision thereof, his office shall thereby be vacated and he shall  
7 thereafter perform no duty and receive no salary or expenses as fire protection district director.

8 2. This section shall not apply to:

9 (1) Members of the organized militia, of the reserve corps, public school employees and notaries  
10 public; [, or to]

11 (2) Fire protection districts located wholly within counties of the second, third or fourth [class or]  
12 classification;

13 (3) Fire protection districts in counties of the first classification with less than eighty-five  
14 thousand inhabitants;

15 (4) Fire protection districts located within [first class] counties of the first classification not  
16 adjoining any other [first class] county of the first classification; [, nor shall this section apply to]

17 (5) Fire protection districts located within any county of the first or second [class] classification  
18 not having more than nine hundred thousand inhabitants which borders any three [first class] counties of  
19 the first classification; [nor shall this section apply to]

20 (6) Fire protection districts located within any [first class] county of the first classification  
21 [without a charter form of government] which adjoins both a [first class] charter county [with a charter  
22 form of government] with at least nine hundred thousand inhabitants, and adjoins at least four other  
23 counties.

25 The term "lucrative office or employment" does not include receiving retirement benefits, compensation  
26 for expenses, or a stipend or per diem, in an amount not to exceed seventy-five dollars for each day of  
27 service, for service rendered to a fire protection district, the state or any political subdivision thereof.”;
