The proposition to levy the tax authorized by 7 this subsection may be submitted by the board of directors at the next annual election of the 8 members of the board or at any regular municipal or school election conducted by the county clerk 9 or board of election commissioners in such district or at a special election called for the purpose, 10 or upon petition of five hundred registered voters of the district.
