AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1458, Page 6, Section 321.162, Line 17,
by inserting the following after all of said Line:

“321.241. 1. The board of directors of any fire protection district may levy, if a majority
of the voters of the district voting thereon approve, in addition to all other taxes heretofore
approved, an additional tax of not more than twenty-five cents per one hundred dollars of assessed
valuation to be used for the support of the district. The proposition to levy the tax authorized by
this subsection may be submitted by the board of directors at the next annual election of the
members of the board or at any regular municipal or school election conducted by the county clerk
or board of election commissioners in such district or at a special election called for the purpose,
or upon petition of five hundred registered voters of the district. A separate ballot containing the
question shall read as follows:

Shall the board of directors of the Fire Protection District be authorized
to levy an additional tax of not more than twenty-five cents on the one hundred dollars assessed
valuation to provide funds for the support of the district?

authorized by this subsection may be submitted by the board of directors at the next annual
election of the members of the board or at any regular municipal or school election conducted by
the county clerk or board of election commissioners in such district or at a special election called

1 for the purpose, or upon petition of five hundred registered voters of the district. A separate ballot
2 containing the question shall read as follows:

16 of assessed valuation to be used for the support of the district. The proposition to levy the tax
17 authorized by this subsection may be submitted by the board of directors at the next annual
18 election of the members of the board or at any regular municipal or school election conducted by
19 the county clerk or board of election commissioners in such district or at a special election called
20 for the purpose, or upon petition of five hundred registered voters of the district. A separate ballot
21 containing the question shall read as follows:

A separate ballot containing the question shall read as follows:

The proposition to levy the tax authorized by this subsection may be submitted by the board of directors at the next annual election of the members of the board or at any regular municipal or school election conducted by the county clerk or board of election commissioners in such district or at a special election called for that purpose, or upon petition of five hundred registered voters of the district. A separate ballot containing the question shall read as follows:

Shall the board of directors of the Fire Protection District be authorized to levy an additional tax of not more than fifty cents on the one hundred dollars assessed valuation to provide funds for the support of the district?
