2	plate which does not bear the Missouri Chapter of the American Red Cross' emblem, as otherwise
3	provided by law. The director of revenue shall make necessary rules and regulations for the
4	enforcement of this section, and shall design all necessary forms required by this section.
5	4. Prior to the issuance of a Missouri Chapter of the American Red Cross specialty
6	personalized plate authorized under this section, the department of revenue must be in receipt of
7	an application, as prescribed by the director, which shall be accompanied by a list of at least two
8	hundred potential applicants who plan to purchase the specialty personalized plate, the proposed
9	art design for the specialty license plate, and an application fee, not to exceed five thousand
10	dollars, to defray the department's cost for issuing, developing, and programming the
