AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 813, Page 41, Section 339.1240, Line 11, by inserting after all of said line the following:

“Section B. 1. Any Missouri resident who, as a result of being extended credit through any credit instrument while a patron of an excursion gambling boat licensed in Missouri, loses control or ownership of their residence, including any continuous adjoining real property to such residence or any other property utilized for income purposes by said patron or other person whose income has been or would be adversely impacted by such loss, shall have the right to file a civil action in the circuit court in the circuit in which the excursion gambling boat is licensed and to recover such real property as a victim of credit induced fraud.

2. For purposes of this section the following terms shall mean:

(1) “Missouri resident”, any individual or member of such individual’s household, or any other individual who is required to change residences or who loses the ability to use any property for the purpose of producing income, who is a citizen of the State of Missouri.

(2) “Credit induced fraud”, any activity which involves any credit instrument in which an excursion gambling boat allows a patron to overextend their credit in such a manner that the patron or a member of the patron’s household has a lien or other indebtedness attached to their residence or continuous adjoining real property to such residence or any other property used for the production of income by any person.”; and

Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
