## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on school districts.

Officials from the **Nixa School District** assume this proposed legislation would have a financial impact on all public schools.

Officials from the **Special School District of St Louis County** state this proposed legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact on their district.

In response to similar legislation from last session, officials from the **Parkway and Independence School Districts** stated this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their districts.

**Oversight** assumes the reporting requirements associated with this proposal can be done with existing resources.

**This proposed legislation was sent to the following school districts, none of which responded to a request for fiscal impact: Blue Springs, Branson, Columbia, Fair Grove, Francis Howell, Jefferson City, Kirksville, Lee's Summit, Mexico, Raytown, Sedalia, Sikeston, Silex, Spickard, Springfield, St Charles, St Joseph, St Louis City, Sullivan.**

### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

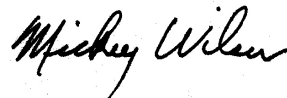
The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
