FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development - Missouri Arts Council** state the current proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Oversight assumes the proposal is permissive in nature. It allows local political subdivisions to create a theater, cultural arts and entertainment district as well as allows those districts to impose a sales tax. Oversight will assume a \$0 or unknown fiscal impact to local political subdivisions. These taxes are subject to voter approval. Oversight will also assume the Department of Revenue, through administrative collection, may generally retain 1 percent of the potential sales tax revenue. Oversight assumes this will have a minimal fiscal impact and has not reflected this on the fiscal note. Oversight assumes, if the sales tax is passed, it would take effect in FY 2014.

Buchanan County did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Small businesses within the district may be required to collect the additional sales tax, dependent upon governing body and voter approval.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation adds Buchanan County and the cities, towns, or villages within Buchanan County to the list of governmental entities that are authorized to establish a Theater, Cultural Arts, and Entertainment taxing district.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
