FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education** responded that this proposal would have no direct foreseeable fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **University of Missouri** did not respond to a request for fiscal impact; however, in a response to HB 582 (FN 1694-01) from last session, UM officials assumed no costs associated with the proposal at that time because the program had not received funding since 2004. UM has continued to request funding, but it has never been restored.

Oversight assumes this proposal increases the amount of the grant that the University of Missouri may distribute to a recipient. Therefore, this proposal does not have a fiscal impact.
