# **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the Little Blue Valley Sewer District, Pulaski County Sewer District, Public Water District #3, Cole County Public Water District #4, City of Columbia, City of Fulton, and City of O'Fallon did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal is permissive in nature and would have no local fiscal impact without action by the governing body ad approved by a majority of voters. Oversight will reflect a \$0 or Unknown impact to Local Political Subdivisions starting in FY 2014.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill authorizes any city, town, village, sewer district, or water supply district to impose, upon voter approval, a fee of up to \$4 per month or \$48 annually for each lateral sewer service line providing sewer service to a residential property having four or fewer dwelling units for the purpose of repair or replacement due to failure of the lateral sewer service lines extending from the residential dwelling to its connection with the public sewer system. The fee may be added to the general tax levy bill of the property owner and collected in the same manner as delinquent real estate taxes and tax bills.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
