HB 1189 -- Pawnbrokers

Sponsor: Allen

Currently, a pawnbroker must require specified proof of identification from every person from whom the pawnbroker receives sold or pledged property. This bill specifies that it must be a valid proof of identification which also includes the person's name and date of birth.

The provision requiring a pawnbroker to hold property acquired from a seller without proof of identification for a period of 30 days is repealed.
