HB 2053 -- School Annexation Petitions

Sponsor: Aull

Currently, a petition on a school district annexation must contain the signatures of 10% of those voting in the last school board election or a majority of the voters of the district, whichever is less. This bill increases the percentage to 20%. If an annexation fails to be approved by voters, a petition for annexation of the same area cannot be circulated for at least two years after the election.
