

HB 2102 -- Table Tap Dispensing Systems

This bill allows any person licensed to sell liquor at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold to use a table tap dispensing system to allow patrons to dispense beer at a table. Before a patron may dispense beer, an employee of the licensee must authorize an amount of beer, not to exceed 32 ounces per patron and per authorization. No law, rule, or regulation of the Supervisor of Alcohol and Tobacco Control in the Department of Public Safety can be interpreted to allow any wholesaler, distributor, or manufacturer of intoxicating liquor to furnish table tap dispensing or cooling equipment or provide services for the maintenance, sanitation, or repair of a dispensing system.
