HJR 73 -- Prohibition of Toll Roads

Sponsor: Smith (150)

Upon voter approval, this proposed constitutional amendment specifies that nothing in the constitution can be construed to authorize the State Highways and Transportation Commission within the Department of Transportation or any state agency to conduct feasibility studies for, or to fund, design, acquire, construct, maintain, reconstruct, or operate toll roads or toll facilities in this state or to enter into any public-private partnership or other contractual agreement for a toll road or toll bridge on any bridge that does not have a toll as of the effective date of the resolution.
