

SS SCS SB 489 & 637 -- WEAPONS

Currently, a person commits a class A misdemeanor if he or she possesses, manufactures, transports, repairs, or sells a switchblade knife. This bill limits the prohibition to when the activity involving a switchblade knife violates federal law and makes the crime a class C felony.

A person can receive a concealed carry endorsement without meeting the current requirements if he or she submits a copy of a certificate of firearms safety training course completion that was issued on or before August 27, 2011, if the certificate met the requirements that were in effect on the date it was issued.

The bill contains an emergency clause.
