1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 18, Page 5, Section 37.850, Line 35, by
2 inserting after all of said line the following:

4 "37.860. 1. The commissioner of the office of administration shall install, operate, and
5 maintain an audio and visual recording of the main entrance to the official offices in the capitol
6 building of the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and president
7 pro tempore of the senate. The recording shall be broadcast live on the internet and shall be archived
8 for no less than seventy-five years. The method of archiving the recording shall allow for
9 reproduction of specific time frames of video upon request.

10 2. The commissioner shall develop a request form to reproduce video, which shall be made
11 available online and in print form. The actual cost of reproduction may be charged to the person
12 requesting the video, but in no case shall such charge exceed ten dollars per hour of recording or
13 parts of thereof. The cost of installing, operating, and maintaining the audio and visual recordings
14 required under this section shall be borne by and paid out of any funds appropriated to the office of
15 administration.

16 3. Upon taking office, the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house, and president
17 pro tem shall inform the commissioner of the location of the main entrance to their respective
18 offices, which shall only be changed during each term in office upon application and approval of the
19 commissioner.

20 4. No registered lobbyist as defined in section 105.470 shall enter or exit the office of
21 governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house, or president pro tem except by the main
22 entrance specified to the commissioner.

23 5. No registered lobbyist as defined in section 105.470 shall discuss any bill, law, contract,
24 or bid for contract with the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house, or president pro tem
25 unless such discussion takes place in such elected official's official office in the capitol building.

26 6. Any willful violation of this section by a registered lobbyist as defined in section 105.470
27 shall be a class A misdemeanor. Any willful violation of this section by the governor, lieutenant
28 governor, speaker of the house, or president pro tem shall be cause for removal from office."; and
