1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 83, Page 9, Section 32.087, Line 191, by inserting after all of said Section and Line  
3 the following:

5 "32.150. 1. Each taxing jurisdiction in the state shall report to the department of revenue all  
6 tax rate and revenue collection information pertaining to the jurisdiction.

7 2. The department of revenue shall display, in an itemized fashion, any non-confidential  
8 information regarding each jurisdiction's tax rates and revenue collections submitted by the taxing  
9 jurisdictions on its website. The information obtained from the taxing jurisdictions shall also be used  
10 by the department for oversight purposes, including verification of compliance, completeness, and  
11 accuracy in reporting with any applicable provisions of law.

12 3. The department shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section. Any  
13 rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority  
14 delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all the  
15 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are  
16 nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly under chapter 536 to review,  
17 to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional,  
18 then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2013, shall  
19 be invalid and void."; and

21 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
22 accordingly.
