1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
2 Senate Bill No. 83, Page 111, Section 302.525, Line 61, by inserting immediately after said line the
3 following:

5 "311.055. 1. No person at least twenty-one years of age shall be required to obtain a license
6 to manufacture intoxicating liquor, as defined in section 311.020, for personal or family use. The
7 aggregate amount of intoxicating liquor manufactured per household shall not exceed two hundred
8 gallons per calendar year if there are two or more persons over the age of twenty-one years in such
9 household, or one hundred gallons per calendar year if there is only one person over the age of
10 twenty-one years in such household. Any intoxicating liquor manufactured under this section may
11 not be offered for sale.

12 2. Beer brewed under this section may be removed from the premises where brewed for
13 personal or family use, including use at organized affairs, exhibitions, or competitions, such as home
14 brewer contests, tastings, or judging. The use may occur off licensed retail premises, on any
15 premises under a temporary retail license issued under sections 311.218, 311.482, 311.485, 311.486,
16 or 311.487, or on any tax exempt organization's licensed premises as described in section 311.090.

17 311.091. 1. Except as provided under subsection 2 of this section and notwithstanding any
18 other provisions of this chapter to the contrary, any person who possesses the qualifications required
19 by this chapter and who meets the requirements of and complies with the provisions of this chapter
20 may apply for and the supervisor of [liquor] alcohol and tobacco control may issue a license to sell
21 intoxicating liquor, as defined in this chapter, by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises
22 of any boat, or other vessel licensed by the United States Coast Guard to carry one hundred or more
23 passengers for hire on navigable waters in or adjacent to this state, which has a regular place of
24 mooring in a location in this state or within two hundred yards of a location which would otherwise
25 be licensable under this chapter. The license shall be valid even though the boat, or other vessel,
26 leaves its regular place of mooring during the course of its operation.

27 2. Any person who possesses the qualifications required by this chapter and who meets the
28 requirements of, and complies with the provisions of, this chapter may apply for, and the supervisor
29 of alcohol and tobacco control may issue, a license to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for
30 consumption on the premises of any boat or other vessel licensed by the United States Coast Guard
31 to carry forty-five to ninety-nine passengers for hire on a lake with a shoreline that is in three
32 counties, one of which is any county of the third classification without a township form of

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1 government and with more than thirty-three thousand but fewer than thirty-seven thousand
2 inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with more than three thousand but fewer than
3 three thousand seven hundred inhabitants as the county seat, one of which is any county of the third
4 classification without a township form of government and with more than twenty-nine thousand but
5 fewer than thirty-three thousand inhabitants and with a city of the fourth classification with more
6 than four hundred but fewer than four hundred fifty inhabitants as the county seat, and one of which
7 is any county of the first classification with more than fifty thousand but fewer than seventy
8 thousand inhabitants. The boat must have a regular place of mooring in a location in this state or
9 within two hundred yards of a location which would otherwise be licensable under this chapter. The
10 license shall be valid even though the boat, or other vessel, leaves its regular place of mooring during
11 the course of its operation.

12 3. For every license for sale of liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises
13 of any boat or other vessel issued under the provisions of this section, the licensee shall pay to the
14 director of revenue the sum of three hundred dollars per year.

15 Section B. Because of the need to clarify the laws relating to beer brewed for personal or
16 family use, the repeal and reenactment of section 311.055 of this act is deemed necessary for the
17 immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be
18 an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and the repeal and reenactment of section
19 311.055 of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; and
