1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 88, Page
2 5, Section 197.100, Line 31, by inserting after all of said section the following:

3 "571.011. 1. Any records of ownership of a firearm or applications for ownership, licensing,
4 certification, permitting, or an endorsement that allows a person to own, acquire, possess, or carry a
5 firearm shall not be open records under chapter 610 and shall not be open for inspection or their
6 contents disclosed except by order of the court to persons having a legitimate interest therein.

7 2. Any person or entity who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a class A
8 misdemeanor.

9 571.012. 1. No health care professional licensed in this state shall be required by law to:

10 (1) Inquire as to whether a patient owns a firearm;

11 (2) Document or maintain in a patient's medical records whether such patient owns a
12 firearm; or

13 (3) Notify any governmental entity of the identity of a patient based solely on the patient's
14 status as an owner of a firearm.

15 2. Nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting or otherwise restricting a health
16 care professional from inquiring, documenting, or otherwise disclosing a patient's status as an owner
17 of a firearm if such inquiry, documentation, or disclosure is necessitated or medically indicated by
18 the health care professional's scope of practice and such inquiry, documentation, or disclosure does
19 not violate any other state or federal law."; and

21 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
22 accordingly.
