 2 In the Title, Line 4, by inserting after "RSMo," the following:

7 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by

12 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 77.030, Line 27, by
 13 deleting the words "the adoption of the ordinance or"; and

15 Further amend said bill, Page 15, Section 115.601, Line 48,
 16 by inserting after all of said line the following:

17 "[77.030. 1. Unless it elects to be governed by
 18 subsection 2 of this section, the council shall by
 19 ordinance divide the city into not less than four
 20 wards, and two councilmen shall be elected from each of
 21 such wards by the qualified voters thereof at the first
 22 election for councilmen in cities hereafter adopting
 23 the provisions of this chapter; the one receiving the
 24 highest number of votes in each ward shall hold his
 25 office for two years, and the one receiving the next
 26 highest number of votes shall hold his office for one
 27 year; but thereafter each ward shall elect annually one
 28 councilman, who shall hold his office for two years.

29 2. In lieu of electing councilmen as provided in
 30 subsection 1 of this section, the council may elect to
 31 establish wards and elect councilmen as provided in
 32 this subsection. If the council so elects, it shall,

1 by ordinance, divide the city into not less than four
2 wards, and one councilman shall be elected from each of
3 such wards by the qualified voters thereof at the first
4 election for councilmen held in the city after it
5 adopts the provisions of this subsection. At the first
6 election held under this subsection the councilmen
7 elected from the odd-numbered wards shall be elected
8 for a term of one year and the councilmen elected from
9 the even-numbered wards shall be elected for a term of
10 two years. At each annual election held thereafter,
11 successors for councilmen whose terms expire in such
12 year shall be elected for a term of two years.

13 3. (1) Council members may serve four-year terms
14 if the two-year terms provided under subsection 1 or 2
15 of this section have been extended to four years by
16 ordinance or by approval of a majority of the voters
17 voting on the proposal.
