1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
2 Senate Bill No. 125, Page 28, Section 168.221, Line 113, by inserting after all of said line the
3 following:

4 "Section 1. 1. Any teacher whose annual evaluation contains an element based on a set
5 percentage to be derived in any manner from the scores of the teacher's students on statewide
6 assessments may calculate the class or course grade of any student who participates in the assessment
7 by allocating a letter or numerical score, as applicable, to the student's statewide assessment score
8 and including the assessment score in the same percentage in calculating the student's grade as the
9 assessment is used in determining the teacher's evaluation. A student assessment score of lower than
10 "proficient" may be grounds for retaining the student in the same grade or for the student to repeat
11 the course.

12 2. State assessment scores shall be made available to teachers in sufficient time for the
13 teachers to use the results in calculating final grades and class and course assignments for the
14 following school year.

15 3. The provisions of this act shall become effective only upon notice by certified mail from
16 the commissioner of education to the revisor of statutes that assessment results are being made
17 available in accordance with the time requirements of subsection 2 of this section."; and
