2	deleting "notice of neighborhood improvement districts" and inserting in lieu thereof "political
3	subdivisions"; and

5	FURTHER AMEND said bill, Section 67.457, Page 4, Line 127, by inserting the following after all
6	of said Line:

8	"Section 1. 1.In any county of the third classification with a township form of government
9	and with more than twenty thousand but fewer than twenty-three thousand inhabitants and with a city
10	of the third classification with more than nine thousand but fewer than ten thousand inhabitants as
11	the county seat that receives an annual payment under the federal "payments in lieu of taxes"
12	program established in Public Law 97-258, 31 U.S.C. 6901 - 6907, if a portion of the payment
13	received by the county is for entitlement lands originally located within any city of the fourth
14	classification with more than four hundred but fewer than four hundred fifty inhabitants, then the
15	county must distribute to the city an amount equal to the number of acres taken from the city
16	multiplied by the tax that would be imposed on the average assessed valuation of an acre of
17	commercial property within the city.
18	2. In any county of the third classification without a township form of government and with
19	more than nine thousand but fewer than ten thousand inhabitants and with a city of the fourth
20	classification with more than nine hundred but fewer than one thousand fifty inhabitants as the
21	county seat that receives an annual payment under the federal "payments in lieu of taxes" program
22	established in Public Law 97-258, 31 U.S.C. 6901 - 6907, if a portion of the payment received by the
23	county is for entitlement lands originally located within any city of the fourth classification with
24	more than nine hundred but fewer than one thousand fifty inhabitants, then the county must
25	distribute to the city an amount equal to the number of acres taken from the city multiplied by the tax
26	that would be imposed on the average assessed valuation of an acre of commercial property within
27	the city."; and

29	Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references

accordingly. 30
