1 AMEND Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 178, Page  
 2 1, Section A, Line 3, by inserting after all of said line the  
 3 following:

4 "9.149. December fourth shall be designated as "PKS Day" in  
 5 Missouri. Pallister-Killian Mosaic Syndrome, commonly known as  
 6 Pallister-Killian Syndrome or PKS, is a disorder usually caused  
 7 by the presence of an abnormal extra chromosome and is  
 8 characterized by vision and hearing impairments, seizure  
 9 disorders, and early childhood, intellectual disability,  
 10 distinctive facial features, sparse hair, areas of unusual skin  
 11 coloring, weak muscle tone, and other birth defects. It is  
 12 recommended to the people of the state that this day be  
 13 appropriately observed by participating in awareness and  
 14 educational activities on the symptoms and impact of Pallister-  
 15 Killian Syndrome and to support programs of research, education,  
 16 and community service."; and
