565.088. 1. A person commits the crime of assault of an employee of a mass transit system
while in the scope of his or her duties in the second degree if such person:
(1) Knowingly causes or attempts to cause physical injury to an employee of a mass transit
system while in the scope of his or her duties by means of a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument.
(2) Knowingly causes or attempts to cause physical injury to an employee of a mass transit
system while in the scope of his or her duties by means other than a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument;
(3) Recklessly causes serious physical injury to an employee of a mass transit system while
in the scope of his or her duties;
(4) While in an intoxicated condition or under the influence of controlled substances or
drugs, operates a motor vehicle in this state and when so operating, acts with criminal negligence to
cause physical injury to an employee of a mass transit system while in the scope of his or her duties;
(5) Acts with criminal negligence to cause physical injury to an employee of a mass transit
system while in the scope of his or her duties by means of a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument;
(6) Purposely or recklessly places an employee of a mass transit system while in the scope of
his or her duties in apprehension of immediate serious physical injury; or
(7) Acts with criminal negligence to create a substantial risk of death or serious physical
injury to an employee of a mass transit system while in the scope of his or her duties.
2. As used in this section, "mass transit system", includes employees of public bus and light
