Officials from the Missouri State Employees Retirement System, Public School and Education Employees Retirement System and MoDOT and Patrol Employees Retirement System each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

In response to similar version of this proposal, officials from the **Joint Committee on Public Retirement** assumed the proposal would not create a substantial proposed change in future plan benefits.

In response to a similar version of this proposal, officials from the County Employees' Retirement Fund and Missouri Local Government Employees' Retirement System each assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Prosecuting and Circuit Attorneys' Retirement System** did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes this proposal clarifies administrative provisions, and will have no fiscal impact.
