FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the Department of Conservation, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Higher Education, Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Linn State Technical College, Metropolitan Community College, Missouri State University, Missouri Western State University, Northwest Missouri State University, Office of Administration - Division of Facilities Management, Design and Construction, Parkway School District, St. Louis County and the University of Central Missouri each assume there is no fiscal impact to their organization from this proposal.

Officials at the **Office of Attorney General** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials at the **University of Missouri** assume this would not have an impact but if it did it would be less than \$100,000 annually.

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** assume the potential of new costs that may be imposed by this proposal. This is dependent upon the difference, if any, between the cost of adding the City, officials and employees as additional insureds to a contractor's insurance and buying an allowable policy, to protect the City.

Oversight did not receive sufficient fiscal impact responses from political subdivisions to determine accurately whether political subdivisions would experience increased costs from this proposal; therefore Oversight will not reflect an impact in the fiscal note.
