

HB 782 -- Membership and Contributions to Public School Retirement Systems in Missouri

This bill prohibits any school district in Missouri from entering into a contract or agreement with a teacher regarding unpaid leave that results in the teacher receiving a paycheck or electronic fund transfer directly from the district in any instance in which an organization is reimbursing the district for the services of the teacher and from entering into a contract or agreement with a teacher that provides for any contribution to a retirement program during a period in which a nonprofit educational association or organization employs the teacher full time and is reimbursing the district for the services of the teacher.

The bill specifies that no person hired after July 1, 2014, by a nonprofit educational association or organization may become a member of the Public School Retirement System of Missouri or the Public Education Employee Retirement System of Missouri.
