1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 605, Page 1, In the Title, Line 5, by
2 deleting the word "higher"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 25, Section 174.770, Line 25, by adding after all of said line the
5 following:

6 "[167.042. For the purpose of minimizing unnecessary investigations due to reports of
7 truancy, each parent, guardian, or other person responsible for the child who causes his child to
8 attend regularly a home school may provide to the recorder of deeds of the county where the child
9 legally resides, or to the chief school officer of the public school district where the child legally
10 resides, a signed, written declaration of enrollment stating their intent for the child to attend a home
11 school within thirty days after the establishment of the home school and by September first annually
12 thereafter. The name and age of each child attending the home school, the address and telephone
13 number of the home school, the name of each person teaching in the home school, and the name,
14 address and signature of each person making the declaration of enrollment shall be included in said
15 notice. A declaration of enrollment to provide a home school shall not be cause to investigate
16 violations of section 167.031. The recorder of deeds may charge a service cost of not more than one
17 dollar for each notice filed.]" and

19 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
20 accordingly.
