1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 615, Page 4, Section 56.807, Line 74, by  
2 inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "452.556. 1. The state courts administrator shall create a handbook or be responsible for the  
5 approval of a handbook outlining the following:

6 (1) What is included in a parenting plan;

7 (2) The benefits of the parties agreeing to a parenting plan which outlines education, custody and  
8 cooperation between parents;

9 (3) The benefits of alternative dispute resolution;

10 (4) The pro se family access motion for enforcement of custody or temporary physical custody;

11 (5) The underlying assumptions for supreme court rules relating to child support; and

12 (6) A party's duties and responsibilities pursuant to section 452.377, including the possible  
13 consequences of not complying with section 452.377. The handbooks shall be distributed to each  
14 court and shall be available in an alternative format, including Braille, large print, or electronic or  
15 audio format upon request by a person with a disability, as defined by the federal Americans with  
16 Disabilities Act.

17 2. Each court shall [mail] provide a copy of the handbook developed pursuant to subsection  
18 1 of this section to each party in a dissolution or legal separation action filed pursuant to section  
19 452.310, or any proceeding in modification thereof, where minor children are involved, or may  
20 provide the petitioner with a copy of the handbook at the time the petition is filed and direct that a  
21 copy of the handbook be served along with the petition and summons upon the respondent.

22 3. The court shall make the handbook available to interested state agencies and members of  
23 the public."; and
