kilowatt hour, if any, when comp	paring the two years. The cost of energy saved per kilowatt hour
multiplied by total energy usage	e in the most recent completed fiscal year is the total cost of saved
energy for the most recent comp	pleted fiscal year. The office of administration shall estimate the total
cost of saved energy for gas con	sumption using identical formulas based on units of gas consumption
such as MMBtu. The total cost	of saved energy will be determined by adding the total cost of saved
energy for electricity and gas us	age.
