1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 601, Page 1, Line 3 of the Title, by deleting the words "an income tax
2 deduction for"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after said line the following:

6 "8.940. 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Office of Administration Energy
7 Conservation Fund", which shall receive fifteen percent of the prior fiscal years total annual cost of
8 saved energy determined under subsection 4 of this section. The state treasurer shall be custodian of
9 the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve
10 disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund, and shall be used solely for energy conservation
11 and energy efficiency purposes.

12 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining
13 in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund.

14 3. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are
15 invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

16 4. The office of administration shall estimate the cost of saved energy for electricity usage
17 using the difference between total electricity cost for baseline fiscal year 2008 and the most recent
18 completed fiscal year to determine kilowatt hours saved, if any, for the most recent completed fiscal
19 year. The cost of energy saved for the most recent completed fiscal year will be determined by
20 calculating the cost per kilowatt hour of the base year and the most recent completed fiscal year
21 using total electricity usage divided by total cost to determine cost per kilowatt hour. Then, the cost
22 of energy saved for the most recent completed fiscal year will depend upon the reduction in cost per
23 kilowatt hour, if any, when comparing the two years. The cost of energy saved per kilowatt hour
24 multiplied by total energy usage in the most recent completed fiscal year is the total cost of saved
25 energy for the most recent completed fiscal year. The office of administration shall estimate the total
26 cost of saved energy for gas consumption using identical formulas based on units of gas consumption
27 such as MMBtu. The total cost of saved energy will be determined by adding the total cost of saved
28 energy for electricity and gas usage.

29 5. If there is no total cost of saved energy during a year, then there will be no requirement to
30 deposit moneys into the fund under this section.

31 6. The office of administration shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this

1 section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under
2 the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to
3 all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536
4 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly under chapter 536 to
5 review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
6 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after
7 August 28, 2014, shall be invalid and void."; and

9 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
10 accordingly.
