AMEND House Amendment No.\_\_\_\_ to Senate Bill No. 601 Page \_\_1\_\_ Line \_\_7\_\_

by inserting prior to the phrase "393.1030." the following:

"393.1025. As used in sections 393.1020 to 393.1030, the following terms mean:

(1) "Commission", the public service commission;

(2) "Department", the department of natural resources;

(3) "Electric utility", any electrical corporation as defined by section 386.020;

(4) "Renewable energy credit" or "REC", a tradeable certificate of proof that one megawatt-hour of electricity has been generated from renewable energy sources; and

(5) "Renewable energy resources", electric energy produced from wind, solar thermal sources, photovoltaic cells and panels, dedicated crops grown for energy production, cellulosic agricultural residues, plant residues, methane from landfills, from agricultural operations, or from wastewater treatment, thermal depolymerization or pyrolysis for converting waste material to energy, clean and untreated wood such as pallets, hydropower (not including pumped storage) [that does not require a new diversion or impoundment of water and that has a nameplate rating of ten megawatts or less], fuel cells using hydrogen produced by one of the above-named renewable energy sources, and other sources of energy not including nuclear that become available after November 4, 2008, and are certified as renewable by rule by the department."; and

Further amend said amendment, Page 3, Line 35, Section 393.1030, by inserting immediately after the phrase "invalid and void." on said line the following:

"393.1032. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all hydroelectric generation facilities located in Missouri, hydroelectric generation facilities that are owned by a Missouri utility, or under a purchased power agreement with a Missouri utility that is required to comply with energy standards under sections 393.1020 to 393.1045, will be classified as a certified renewable energy resource effective January 1, 2018. Beginning January 1, 2021, all hydroelectric generation will be classified as a certified renewable energy resource. Such certification as a

1 renewable energy resource will become effective immediately upon the occurrence of the delayed  
2 effective dates in this section, and will not require any additional certification from the division of  
3 energy of the Missouri department of economic development or an equivalent agency.

4 2. Prior to August 28, 2014, existing hydroelectric generation facilities that have met the  
5 definition of a renewable energy resource and have been certified as such by the division of energy  
6 of the Missouri department of economic development or an equivalent agency shall be considered to  
7 be renewable energy resources under sections 393.1020 to 393.1045."; and
