1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 601, in the Title, Line 3 by deleting the phrase "an income tax deduction
2 for"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 5, Section 143.121, Line 149, by inserting after all of said section and
5 line the following:

7 "Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the commission shall
8 make available the solar rebates authorized under subsection 3 of section 393.1030 on a first come,
9 first served basis until there is a final commission ruling indicating that the maximum average retail
10 rate increase of one percent under subdivision (1) of subsection 2 of section 393.1030 has been met.
11 The commission shall not have authority to segregate or withhold funds based on the classification of
12 renewable energy sources. Any commission rule to the contrary is invalid and void. The
13 commission, as authorized under subsection 4 of section 393.1030 may promulgate rules for offering
14 rebates based on renewable energy sources other than solar power on a first come, first served basis,
15 but this shall not be interpreted to allow the commission to cease offering solar rebates."; and

17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
18 accordingly.
