1 AMEND House Bill No. 1219, Page 1, Line 3 of the Title by deleting the words "absentee ballots" 2 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "elections"; and 3 4 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 115.293, Line 11 by inserting after said line the following: 5 6 "321.130. [1.] A person, to be qualified to serve as a director, shall be a resident and voter of the district for at least one year before the election or appointment and be over the age of twenty-five 7 8 vears[; except as provided in subsections 2 and 3 of this section. The person shall also be a resident 9 of such fire protection district]. In the event the person is no longer a resident of the district, the 10 person's office shall be vacated, and the vacancy shall be filled as provided in section 321.200. Nominations and declarations of candidacy shall be filed at the headquarters of the fire protection 11 12 district by paying a [ten dollar] filing fee equal to the amount of a candidate for county office as set 13 forth under section 115.357, and filing a statement under oath that such person possesses the required 14 qualifications. 15 [2. In any fire protection district located in more than one county one of which is a first class 16 county without a charter form of government having a population of more than one hundred ninety-eight thousand and not adjoining any other first class county or located wholly within a first 17 18 class county as described herein, a resident shall have been a resident of the district for more than 19 one year to be qualified to serve as a director. 20 3. In any fire protection district located in a county of the third or fourth classification, a 21 person to be qualified to serve as a director shall be over the age of twenty-five years and shall be a 22 voter of the district for more than one year before the election or appointment, except that for the 23 first board of directors in such district, a person need only be a voter of the district for one year 24 before the election or appointment. 25 4. A person desiring to become a candidate for the first board of directors of the proposed 26 district shall pay the sum of five dollars as a filing fee to the treasurer of the county and shall file 27 with the election authority a statement under oath that such person possesses all of the qualifications 28 set out in this chapter for a director of a fire protection district.] Thereafter, such candidate shall have the candidate's name placed on the ballot as a candidate for director. 29 30 321.210. On the first Tuesday in April after the expiration of at least two full calendar years from the date of the election of the first board of directors, and on the first Tuesday in April every 31 32 two years thereafter, an election for members of the board of directors shall be held in the district.
