1 AMEND House Bill No. 1490, Page 1, Section 161.855, Lines 1 to 7,  
 2 by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the  
 3 following:

4 "161.855. 1. By October 1, 2014, the state board of  
 5 education shall convene work groups composed of education  
 6 professionals to develop and recommend new academic performance  
 7 standards in place of the common core state standards. The work  
 8 groups shall be composed of individuals as provided in section  
 9 160.514. The state board of education and the work groups shall  
 10 follow the procedures and conduct the public hearings required by  
 11 section 160.514. The state board of education shall convene  
 12 separate work groups for the following subject areas: English  
 13 language arts; mathematics; science; and history and governments.  
 14 For each of these four subject areas, the state board of  
 15 education shall convene two separate work groups, one work group  
 16 for grades kindergarten through five and another work group for  
 17 grades six through twelve.

18 2. The work groups shall develop and recommend new academic  
 19 performance standards in place of the common core state standards  
 20 to the state board of education by October 1, 2015. The work  
 21 groups shall report on their progress in developing the academic  
 22 performance standards to the president pro tempore of the senate  
 23 and the speaker of the house of representatives on a monthly  
 24 basis.

25 3. The state board of education shall adopt and implement  
 26 new academic performance standards in place of the common core  
 27 state standards beginning in the 2016-2017 school year. The  
 28 state board of education shall align the statewide assessment  
 29 system to the new academic performance standards as needed within
