1 AMEND House Bill No. 1490, Page 1, in the Title , Lines 2 and 3, by deleting the words, "the  
2 Common Core Standards Initiative" and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "elementary and  
3 secondary education"; and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said line the following:

7 "161.022. 1. The state board of education consists of eight lay members appointed by the  
8 governor, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, after an open committee hearing. The  
9 term of office of each member is eight years. At the expiration of the term of each member, the  
10 governor, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a successor. If the general  
11 assembly is not in session at the time for making an appointment, the governor shall make a  
12 temporary appointment as in the case of a vacancy.

13 2. After August 28, 2014, no member shall serve more than two terms on the state board of  
14 education and any member who has already served two or more terms on the board shall be  
15 ineligible to serve an additional term. In applying this subsection, serving a term for less than four  
16 years shall not be counted.

17 3. No member may be removed by the governor except after written notice and hearing on  
18 charges of malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in office.

19 [3.] 4. Each member of the board shall receive as compensation for his services twenty-five  
20 dollars for each day actually spent in attendance at board meetings, and in addition shall be  
21 reimbursed for all necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties as a member of the  
22 board."; and

24 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
25 accordingly.
