8	2. For purposes of this section "farm products" shall mean any fresh fruits, vegetables,
9	mushrooms, nuts, shell eggs, honey or other bee products, maple syrup or maple sugar, flowers,
10	nursery stock and other horticultural commodities, livestock food products, including meat, milk,
11	cheese, and other dairy products, food products of "aquaculture", as defined in section 277.024,
12	including fish, oysters, clams, mussels, and other molluscan shellfish taken from the waters of the
13	state, products from any tree, vine, or plant and other flowers, or any of the products listed in this
14	subdivision that have been processed by the participating farmer, including, but not limited to, baked
15	goods made with farm products.
16	3. For purposes of this section "farmers' market" shall mean an individual farmer or a
17	cooperative or nonprofit enterprise or association that consistently occupies a given site throughout
18	the season, which operates principally as a common marketplace for an individual farmer or a group
19	of farmers to sell farm products directly to consumers and where the products sold are produced by
20	the participating farmers with the sole intent and purpose of generating a portion of household
21	income.
22	4. The provisions of this section do not apply to any farmer with estimated total annual sales
23	of twenty-five thousand dollars or more from participating in farmers' markets."; and
